- 7. In chapter 8, Matthew reports on how Jesus healed different people. Write down what Jesus in order to heal them.

 - **b. Verses 5-13**
 - c. Verses 14-15
 - d. Verses 28-34
- 8. In Mark 5:24-34 is the story of the woman who was healed from her bleeding. What did she do to secure her healing?
- 9. In the passages in questions 8 & 9, for how many people did Jesus pray to God that they would be healed?
- 10. How was the lame man healed in Acts 3:1-9. Did Peter or John pray to God to heal him? How were they healed?
- 11. How did Jesus say we should remove mountains? Mark 11,23
- 12. How did Jesus define His ministry? Luke 4:18
- 13. What promise is in John 14:12?

Note! A Spirit filled person is anointed! They are filled with the power of God to do the same works that Jesus did. But we have to do the works the same way Jesus did them. It is not just praying that God would heal someone. We must release the anointing into the situation or into the person with the need. We do this the same way Jesus and His disciples did it: through laying our hands on someone, or through commanding or through the Name of Jesus.
